The application fee of PLN 200.00 (EUR 55.00) per person (STFZ members — PLN 100.00) shall be paid to SFTZ account: Bank BISE III O/Warszawa, 13701037-500702-27005.

The application fee covers the conference costs, two meals, participation in the banquet, conference materials, transfer to and from Wieliczka, stay in Wieliczka. The application fee does not include accommodation costs.

Two delegates from each organisation belonging to AOE network are exempt from application fee.

Accommodation in rooms for 1-7 person(s), in hotels and dormitories booked by SFTZ, prices from PLN 30.00 (EUR 8.00) to PLN 290.00 (EUR 75.00) per night per person, payable by participants. The costs of accommodation and application fee for participants from the former Soviet Union shall be covered by the organisers, after previous agreeing.

## **Important information**

- Please take your name punch with you to Kraków.
- We shall not guarantee the room size a participant may be lodged with other conference participants.
- The conference language is English.
- Please take warm clothes with you on the second conference day you will be exposed to temperature of  $13^{\circ}$ C (Wieliczka salt mine).
- One can comfortably and cheaply move around the town with taxis called by phone (from the hotel reception desk) or stopped in the street, but always use the ones marked as RADIO-TAXI.
- When using public transport, cancel your ticket immediately after entering the tram or the bus — you can buy them in news-stand kiosks.
